North Carolina grown Christmas trees accounts for 20% of the trees sold in the US every Christmas

Every acre of Christmas Trees grown produces the daily oxygen requirement for 18 people.

It takes 12 years to grow a 6-7 foot tree. How many years do you think it would take to grow this tree?

The Christmas trees growing in the United States absorb and store 4200 pounds of Carbon every day.

That is the equivalent of taking 300,000 automobiles off the road.

For every Real Christmas Tree harvested, 1 to 3 seedlings are planted in its place.

The farms that grow Christmas Trees stabilize soil, protect water supplies and provide refuge for wildlife while creating scenic green belts. Often, Christmas Trees are grown on soil that doesn't support other crops.
